

Sample Horticulture Reasons – Carrots

Sir, Ma'am, Madam,

I placed this class of half-long carrots 2-1-4-3. In reviewing this class I found a definite top plate of carrots in plate 2 with a much closer middle and bottom pair.

Plate two easily places at the top of the class and over plate 1 because of excellent color and general appearance. The carrots on plate 2 were very uniform in length and diameter and exhibited no cracks or branches. The carrots on plate 2 also exhibited a much brighter more appealing color as displayed than those on plate 1. Having no grants I will move to my middle pair.

When placing plate 1 over plate 4 I noticed that the carrots in plate 1 were more consistent in length than plate 4. Plate one also displayed carrots that were smoother and straighter than the items in plate 4. The carrots in plate 1 also exhibited fewer wrinkles than those of plate 4. I will grant that the carrots in plate 4 were much straighter than those displayed on plate 1.

In my bottom pair I place plate 4 over plate 3. This was a very close placing but I did find the carrots on plate 4 to have an advantage in yield of product than the carrots in plate 4 to be more uniform throughout than the items in plate 3. I criticize the carrots in plate 3 and placed them at the bottom of the class for having the poorest color, lacking uniformity and containing splits one of the carrots.

These are my reasons for placing this class of half-long carrots 2-1-4-3.
