

**FFA Member Application
Batch Scoring Criteria (Rubric)**

Academic Achievement (30 points total)

GPA Score (10 points) –

$$(GPA * 2.5) = x$$

ACT/SAT Score (10 points) – Student will receive credit for only one score. Student will receive credit for highest point value if they report both an ACT and SAT score:

ACT score formula: $(\text{Student Score} / 36) * 10 = x$

SAT score formula/1600 scale: $(\text{Student Score} / 1600) * 10 = x$

SAT score formula/2400 scale: $(\text{Student Score} / 2400) * 10 = x$

Class Rank (10 points) –

$$(\text{Total \# in graduating class} - \text{class rank}) / (\text{Total \# in graduating class}) * 10 = x$$

Leadership (30 points total)

3 points for each different leadership activity reported (24 points possible)

6 points credited for service as an FFA Officer

Community Service (10 points total)

2.5 points credited for each different community service activity reported

SAE (30 points total)

- 1. Do you have an SAE:** 6 points credited for “yes” answer and selection of an enterprise type
- 2. SAE Goals:** 2 points credited for each stated goal the student developed as a part of their SAE program (6 points total)
- 3. Goal Achievement:** 6 points credited for achieving the stated goals and full description of the level of achievement on the stated goals.
- 4. Skills:** 2 points credited for each stated skill the student developed as a part of their SAE program. (6 points total)
- 5. Future Goals:** 6 points credited for a complete description of the student’s career, educational and personal goals for the next 10 years

Selection Notes

National FFA uses application scores resulting from batch scoring along with sponsor criteria to determine the top applicants qualified for each individual scholarship. Selectors conduct a thorough visual review to determine the recipient(s) once narrowed down to only the top candidates. This review may require further inspection of specific areas of the student application or the entire student application depending upon the requirements of the scholarship for which selection is taking place.
