



# How to become a New Mexico FFA Member?

**To be eligible for active membership in a chartered FFA Chapter**, a student must be enrolled in a middle school or secondary agricultural education program.

**To become an active member and retain membership, a student must:**

1. While in school, be enrolled in at least one agricultural education course during the school year and/or follow a planned course of study; either course must include a supervised agricultural experience program, the objective of which is preparation for an agricultural career (National FFA Constitution Article V Section B).
2. Show an interest in the affairs of the organization by attending meetings, striving for degrees of membership and participating in other organized activities of the chapter.
3. Pay all current local, state and national dues by the date determined by the chapter.
4. Display conduct consistent with the ideals and purposes of the National FFA Organization.
5. Meet all school policies and guidelines related to Agricultural Education and the FFA.
6. Students must physically attend an agricultural education class at the student's home school district or open enrollment choice, in accordance with NMAA guidelines.

## No FFA Chapter in your school?

FFA membership is also available to students enrolled in a home-schooled education program. However, students must meet criteria listed above.

*(Rules governing acceptance of an outside student from their school district must be decided upon by both the in-district school **and** the host school district & FFA Advisor.)*
